

CONTRACT FOR SUPERVISION- ASOTP Addendum

This agreement is made between _____ (herein after referred to as the supervisee) and **John Doe, MA, LPC-S, LSOTP-S** (herein after referred to as the supervisor). The supervisor agrees to provide supervision in compliance with the requirements of the Texas Administrative Code Chapter 810 and in accordance with the terms below. All components of the primary contract must be adhered to. This addendum is supplemental to all previously signed and agreed upon terms in the initial Supervision Contract. The parties mutually agree to the following:

Frequency and Duration:

Per Texas Administrative Code, Rule 810.3 (8) (C), An ASOTP shall receive face-to-face supervision at least 1 hour per 20 hours of assessment and treatment with a minimum of 2 hours per month during any time period in which the supervisee provides sex offender assessment and treatment. Exceptions to supervision requirements shall be approved on a case-by-case basis by the council. Face-to-face supervision may be conducted through audio-visual means when distance or other factors preclude in-person meetings.

Availability:

Supervision shall occur on a set and agreed upon schedule. The supervisor may be available between scheduled sessions, as needed, for phone consultation during regular business hours (M – F, 9:00 am – 6:00 pm). Compensation:

In exchange for supervisor’s time, expertise and licensure, the supervisor shall be compensated **\$20 per session (note: this is in addition to the fees owed for LPC Intern Supervision)**, payable by the end of each month.

Duration and Termination:

The period of this agreement shall be from:

OR

From start date _____ until such time supervisee meets the hour and supervision requirements for licensure, or the agreement is otherwise terminated. Either party upon 30 days notice may terminate the agreement. The agreement may be immediately terminated if either part does not maintain necessary qualifications or fails to follow Texas Administrative Code Chapter 810.

Both parties agree to comply with Title 22 Texas Administrative Code, Chapter 810 for the entirety of the supervision contract.
